

Job Title: Electrician I Supervisor: Electrician Crew Leader

Job Summary

Position is responsible for the maintenance and repair of minor electrical equipment, minor motor controls and the installation and repairs fluorescent, industrial and general lighting fixtures and connections.

Essential Duties

- 1. Repairs minor electrical equipment, minor motor controls
- 2. Installs and repairs fluorescent, industrial and general lighting fixtures and connections.
- 3. Performs minor additions to existing wiring.
- 4. Installs and repairs all electrical outlets and switches
- 5. Performs all related work in compliance with the National Electrical Code.
- 6. Performs preventative maintenance on crucial life safety equipment the buildings as assigned and keep an updated log.
- 7. Models nondiscriminatory practices in all activities

(These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

Other Duties

Performs any other related duties as assigned by the Electrician Crew Leader or appropriate administrator.

Job Specifications

Minimum Qualifications (Knowledge, Skills and/or Abilities Required)

Completion of a standard high school or GED. Knowledge of the standard practices, tools, and terminology of the electrical trade. Good knowledge of elementary electrical theory; ability to make repairs to electrical wiring devices, lighting fixtures and minor electrical equipment. Must possess a valid Virginia Driver's License.

Working Conditions and Physical Requirements

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform essential functions. Demonstrates ability to climb ladders and work at heights up to 60 feet. (Height reached by bucket truck and single man lift). Must have the ability to stand for extended periods of time; exhibit manual dexterity to operate equipment; see and read printed material with or without vision aids; hear and understand speech at normal levels; speak in audible tones so that others may understand clearly in person and on the telephone; ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions; physical agility to lift 50 pounds; to bend, stoop and reach overhead.

Work Environment

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Duties are normally performed inside and outside in a workshop/building environment. The noise level in the work environment is sometimes loud but usually moderate.
