Job Summary

Position is responsible for providing clerical office support.

Essential Duties

1. Assists teachers with audio-visual and computer equipment.
2. Assists the teachers and administrators in monitoring the classrooms and surrounding areas.
3. Monitors computer lab.
4. Bus monitor for arrival & dismissal times.
5. Responsible for daily student lunch pick-up.
6. Assists with special events.
7. Models nondiscriminatory practices in all activities.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff and the general public. Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions. Proficiency in NovaNet preferred.
